



## How to separate the waste

You have told us about the waste that you want to dispose of. You can use your own bags for the disposal but please separate the waste as follows:

### ❖ **General harmless waste**

i.e. galley waste, plastic, tins, paper, glass etc.

**! Everything can go in one bag !**

### ❖ **Non harmless waste**

**! Please use a different bag for each group of non harmless waste !**

| Group 1: | i.e. oil contaminated workshop-waste, gloves, rags etc.         |
| Group 2: | i.e. chemical residue, paint residue, detergents, medicine etc. |
| Group 3: | fluorescent lamps   |
| Group 4: | dry batteries   |
| Group 5: | wet and starter batteries, lead-acid accus.                     |

- ❖ When the bags are ready, please phone the harbourmaster on +49 (0) 4124 - 91230.
- ❖ A member of our staff will then come to your vessel to check and sign for the waste.
- ❖ Please put your waste into the container which has been shown to you by our staff.
- ❖ The non harmless waste will be checked and taken over by a member of staff of the disposal company.
- ❖ The signed form is your proof for waste disposal. Please keep it safe as you might need to show it on request.

**! Do not – under any circumstances – leave any waste on the pier !**
